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What are the Digital Humanities?

"Nowadays, the term can mean anything from media studies to electronic art, from data mining to edutech, from scholarly editing to anarchic blogging, while inviting code junkies, digital artists, standards wonks, transhumanists, game theorists, free culture advocates, archivists, librarians, and edupunks under its capacious canvas."

Digital humanities are also "a series of concrete instantiations involving money, students, funding agencies...programs, curricula...gatekeepers, and prestige. It might be more than these things, but it **cannot not** be these things." (Ramsay, 2011)



30 letters to and from Voltaire and 4 sheets of poems. Collection acquired in 1945 for \$123 (roughly \$1200 today). Creation of a digital edition.


"Voltaire opened a door and I saw hundreds of papers.






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Voltaire @ USC: Situating the publication of the letters at the intersection of several genres in digital scholarship, digital publishing, and the digital humanities, generally speaking.

- Inconstant funding;
- ad hoc staff support;
- no formal institutional support;
- lack of transparency;
- ad hoc decision-making;
- no space;
- limited technological access;
- little guidance on data management/planning;
- informality;
- grassroots;
- little formal consideration in promotion or scholarship...




Creating the digital edition of the letters involved the following frameworks:


Scalar, scalar.usc.edu Alliance for Networking Visual Culture

Free, open source authoring and publishing platform that enables users to assemble media from multiple sources and juxtapose them with their own long-form, born-digital writing. It requires minimal technical expertise.



- Engaging students as contributors, and potentially as curators
