

Project goals:

- Preserving full collections of the three magazines in digital form
- Preserving and conveying the cultural "flavor" of the late
 XXth century in the Nordic countries, including
 - information about local music acts
 - the attitude of Nordic music community to worldwide sensations
 - snapshots of associated subculture movements, etc.
- Making this important knowledge available online




Overall project volume: over 16.450 pages

Digitization workforce: 4 to 8 operators

Timeframe: about 9 months







Project requirements:

Full-text recognition

High recognition accuracy (to ensure excellent searchability of the collection)

Excluding part of material from recognition (commercials, etc.)

Results: industry-standard XML format

In some parts of scope – illustrations were extracted & saved in a separate location, hyperlink placed in the XML file



Complications:

- The specifics of periodicals as input material:
 - Wide format and multi-column layout (challenge for automatic segmentation)

Solution: manual after-correction of automatic segmentation

- Colored and textured backgrounds (challenge for OCR)

Solution: semi-automated image preprocessing in graphic packages (increasing contrast, etc.)

- A variety of fonts and font colors within one page
- Designer fonts used
- Skewed fragments + fragments with normal text orientation present in one page

Solution: KFI of poorly recognized or unrecognized occurrences

- Inverted and «normal» text present on one page

Solution: multi-attempt OCR with varied settings (inverted/normal text)


Which has just had its première. Which has just had its première. What is special about this festival is that the main focus is on the composer of jazz music. It has also been the ambition of the festival to reflect the Nordic jazz scene. Last, but definitely not least, a part of the festival has been devoted to seminars in collaboration with the music colleges.

The commissioning of works from the composers who take part in the festival also means that the audience is given the chance to make the acquaintance of completely new compositions,

It is common practice when organizing festivals of western art music to focus on the composer; this gives audiences an opportunity to become more familiar with the musical language and works of a few select composers. In jazz it is a well-known fact that the composer also often plays an active role as a musician. However, there are a certain number of artists in the jazz world who have put most of their energy into composing. These composers have often had a significant influence on the stylistic development of jazz: they include Thelonious Monk, George Russell, Duke Ellington, Charlie Mingus and Bob Brookmeyer, as well as Nordic jazz composers such as Palle Mikkelborg, Jan Johansson, Lars Gullin, Jan Garbarek and Heikki Sarmanto.

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Eivind Groven's Draumkvædet is based on an old Norwegian ballad about Olav Asteson, who fell intoa deep sleep which lasted all the twelve days of Christmas. When he awoke he went to church and related the vision he had experienced, in which he not only wandered through the Kingdom of the Dead but also saw the Day of Judgment. Groven (1901-77) used three of the melodies to which the ballad is still sung in his treatment of this ancient song from Telemark. The recording was made in connection with a concert performance in London, and the English choir catches the Norwegian linguistic tone and the rough and ready style of the music remarkably well. Only the opera mannerisms of the tenor soloist seem a little out of place.




NORWEGIAN COMPOSERS



Sparre Olsen was born in 1903 tion by Toril Carlsen, and to and is thus a veteran of Norwegian music. The eight pieces acute in the circumstances

on this record span a period of more than half a century right up to Metamorphosis for solo cello from 1982. The sleeve notes rightly emphasise that Sparre Olsen has made his most notable contribution as a vocal composer, which makes it all the more odd that the anthology only includes one vocal item, Two Edda Poems (1946) for soprano and orchestra. The poems are sung pleasantly but with almost no text articulation by Toril Carlsen, and the lack of a word-sheet is particularly

Here the splendid Norwegian oboist Brynjar Hoff plays four works dedicated to him personally. The sleeve shows him in a suitably Romantic get-eup, and the contents correspond precisely to the packaging. Søderlind adds a taste of Arabic exoticism to his Romantic broth, while there is an Indian touch to Sigurd Berge's music. But the results are always gratifying, and it is no wonder that this record has been one of the biggest sales successes in the



Complications:

- Format specifics:
 - Input material: TIFF, PDF the latter sometimes containing a text layer, which was sometimes partially unrecognizable (in vector format)

Solution: OCR of PDF as image-only (sometimes), or KFI of unrecognized information

- Output requirements: XML format, different from that produced automatically by ABBYY FineReader

Solution: export to Microsoft Word, semi-automatic XML markup in required format

- Language specifics:
 - Several languages (Danish & English) on one page (additional challenge for OCR even with correct dictionaries enabled)
 - Critical information in Danish

Solution: operators with linguistic background, manual verification

XML format requirements:

- One XML file per article (including multi-page articles)
- Metadata block: magazine name, issue (e.g. 2007-12), article number on page
- Article level tags: type of article (interview, musical review, news piece, etc.), author, abstract
- Formatting tags: title, subtitle, text type (bold, italic, bold italic), etc.
- Special tags (occurrences of proper and geographical names, etc.)

Process phases (scope of work):

- 1. Analysis/segmentation of pages (automatic)
- 2. Segmentation cross-check & correction (manual)
- 3. OCR (automatic)
- 4. Verification/correction or KFI if unrecognized (manual)
- 5. Export to Microsoft Word (automatic)
- 6. XML markup (manual, semi-automated)
- 7. XML file aggregation (merging several files related to one article)* (manual)
- 8. XML validation (automatic)
- * Optional phase (is case of issues with automatic article segmentation)
