Goals

Actions Taken

- Professional and Regional Council workshop held, and worksheets created
- Results from the IFLA and Trends survey published, and Trends a highlight of the November/December townhalls

3: Engage members and partners, focusing on communication and transparency

Goals

- Pursue regular communication with Members about HQ and GB work
- Enhance outreach to all parts of the world

Actions Taken

- Townhalls held and recording shared
- President's message around December GB issued to members and volunteers
- Survey issued on the future IFLA newsletter

4: Ensure effective and well functioning IFLA governance

Goals

- Complete Governance Structure Health Check and implement its findings
- Implement Code of Conduct for volunteers

Actions Taken

- Townhalls on Governance Structure Health Check completed
- GB discussion about IFLA's future elections highlight priorities for next time

5: Move IFLA's financial sustainability strategy forwards

Goals

- Maintain balanced IFLA budgets
- Ensure investments in capacity to contribute to long-term sustainability

Actions Taken

- Business Development Manager hired to strengthen capacity for IFLA and the field
- 2025 budget forecast continues to anticipate a balanced result

6: Introduce our new WLIC model, working together, starting with Busan 2026

Goals

- Deliver successful 2026 and 2027, implementing WLIC review findings
- Enable evaluation of impacts

Actions Taken

- Main calls for WLIC 2026 issued, and programme committee already well advanced
- Call for potential hosts in 2028 and 2029 issued

7: Make IFLA100 dynamic, global and inclusive, focused on the past and the future

Goals

- IFLA100 builds engagement in IFLA across geographies and communities
- Boost the field as it enters its 2nd century

Actions Taken

- Ongoing preparations for announcements in January
- Updated timeline for events shared with the Governing Board in December
